Property Description

BEING the description of a parcel of land to be known hereafter as Timberon Golf Course Subdivision, Unit 8, lying in and being a portion of Sections 22 and 23, Township 19 South, Range 12 East of the New Mexico Principal Meridian in Otero County, New Mexico and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at the corner common to Sections 22, 23, 26 and 27 in Township 19 South, Range 12 East of the New Mexico Principal Meridian in Otero County, New Mexico; thence North 25°01'08" East a distance of 1602.41 feet to a point lying in the Easterly right of way line of Sacramento Drive (50 foot wide road), said point being the true point of BEGINNING of the parcel of land being described;

THENCE South 85°47'00" West across Sacramento Drive a distance of 50.00 feet to a point lying in the Westerly right of way line of said Drive, and said point being the P.C. of a curve return to the right in a Southwesterly direction;

THENCE a distance of 31.41 feet along the arc of a curve to the right, whose central angle is 90°00'00", whose radius is 20.00 feet and whose long chord bears South 40°47'00" West a distance of 28.28 feet to the P.T. of said curve lying in the Northerly right of way line of Oakmont Drive;

THENCE South 85°47'00" West along the Northerly right of way line of Oakmont Drive a distance of 260.25 feet to the P.C. of a curve to the left;

THENCE continuing along the Northerly right of way line of Oakmont Drive a distance of 304.24 feet along the arc of a curve to the left, whose central angle is 12°25'00", whose radius is 1403.31 feet and whose long chord bears South 79°34'30" West a distance of 303.65 feet to the P.T. of said curve;

THENCE South 73°22'00" West a distance of 104.61 feet to a point lying in the Northerly right of way line of Oakmont Drive;

THENCE South 16°38'00" East crossing Oakmont Drive (50 foot wide road) a distance of 230.25 feet to a point;

THENCE South 73°22'00" West a distance of 23.93 feet to a point;

THENCE South 16°38'00" East a distance of 162.77 feet to a point lying in the Northerly right of way line of Paradise Valley Drive;

THENCE along the Northerly right of way line of Paradise Valley Drive, South 73°22'00" West a distance of 33.00 feet to the P.C. of a curve in the Northerly right of way line of said Drive;

THENCE South 16°38'00" East crossing Paradise Valley Drive (50 foot wide road) a distance of 200.00 feet to a point;

THENCE South 82°10'00" West a distance of 162.93 feet to a point;

THENCE South 04°58'00" East a distance of 50.00 feet to a point;

THENCE South 25°01'14" West a distance of 341.06 feet to a point;

THENCE North 75°04'11" West a distance of 175.81 feet to a point;

THENCE North 61°45'33" West a distance of 407.22 feet to a point;

THENCE North 36°22'10" West a distance of 130.17 feet to a point;

THENCE North 33°34'00" East a distance of 251.00 feet to a point lying in the Southwesterly right of way line of Paradise Valley Drive, and said point being the P.C. of a curve to the right;

THENCE along the Southwesterly right of way line of Paradise Valley Drive a distance of 129.53 feet along the arc of a curve to the right, whose central angle is 28°34'00", whose radius is 1124.96 feet, and whose long chord bears North 51°39'00" West a distance of 123.29 feet to the P.T. of said curve;

THENCE North 46°52'00" West a distance of 276.90 feet to a point lying in the Southwesterly right of way line of Paradise Valley Drive;

THENCE South 43°08'00" West a distance of 200.00 feet to a point;

THENCE North 49°03'26" West a distance of 250.00 feet to a point;

THENCE North 57°49'08" East a distance of 254.64 feet to a point;

THENCE North 43°08'00" East a distance of 253.38 feet to a point lying in the Southwesterly right of way line of Paradise Valley Drive;

THENCE South 46°52'00" East a distance of 10.00 feet to a point lying in the Southwesterly right of way line of Paradise Valley Drive (50 foot wide road);

THENCE North 43°08'00" East across Paradise Valley Drive a distance of 50.00 feet to the P.C. of a curve return to the right lying in the Northwesterly right of way line of Paradise Valley Drive;

THENCE a distance of 31.41 feet along the arc of a curve to the right, whose central angle is 90°00'00", whose radius is 20.00 feet and whose long chord bears North 01°52'00" West a distance of 28.28 feet to a point lying in the Southwesterly right of way line of Saugahatchee Way;

THENCE North 43°08'00" East along the Southwesterly right of way line of Saugahatchee Way a distance of 310.00 feet to the P.C. of a curve return to the right;

THENCE a distance of 31.41 feet along the arc of a curve to the right, whose central angle is 90°00'00", whose radius is 20.00 feet and whose long chord bears North 88°08'00" East a distance of 28.28 feet to a point lying in the Southwesterly right of way line of Oakmont Drive (50 foot wide road);

THENCE South 46°52'00" East along the Southwesterly right of way line of Oakmont Drive a distance of 241.77 feet to a point lying in the Northerly right of way line of Oakmont Drive and said point being the P.C. of a curve return to the right;

THENCE a distance of 31.41 feet along the arc of a curve to the right, whose central angle is 90°00'00", whose radius is 20.00 feet and whose long chord bears North 01°52'00" West a distance of 28.28 feet to a point lying in the Southwesterly right of way line of Noyac Loop and said point being the P.C. of a compound curve to the right;

THENCE along the Southwesterly right of way line of Noyac Loop a distance of 93.38 feet along the arc of a curve to the right, whose central angle is 70°56'38", whose radius is 80.26 feet and whose long chord bears North 78°36'20" East a distance of 93.15 feet to the P.C. of a reverse curve to the left;

THENCE continuing along the Southwesterly right of way line of Noyac Loop a distance of 390.78 feet along the arc of a curve to the left, whose central angle is 67°37'00", whose radius is 331.13 feet and whose long chord bears North 80°16'06" East a distance of 368.43 feet to the P.C. of a curve to the left;

THENCE continuing along the Easterly right of way line of Noyac Loop a distance of 374.37 feet along the arc of a curve to the left, whose central angle is 81°43'00", whose radius is 264.11 feet and whose long chord bears North 05°51'07" East a distance of 343.81 feet to the P.C. of a reverse curve to the right;

THENCE continuing along the Easterly right of way line of Noyac Loop a distance of 101.38 feet along the arc of a curve to the right, whose central angle is 68°55'23", whose radius is 34.28 feet and whose long chord bears North 00°17'41" West a distance of 25.38 feet to the P.C. of a curve return to the right;

THENCE a distance of 31.41 feet along the arc of a curve to the right, whose central angle is 90°00'00", whose radius is 20.00 feet and whose long chord bears North 79°10'00" East a distance of 28.28 feet to a point lying in the Southwesterly right of way line of Pawhuska Drive;

THENCE South 55°50'00" East along the Southwesterly right of way line of Pawhuska Drive a distance of 103.00 feet to the P.C. of a curve to the left;

THENCE continuing along the Southwesterly right of way line of Pawhuska Drive a distance of 205.27 feet along the arc of a curve to the left, whose central angle is 14°32'00", whose radius is 809.24 feet and whose long chord bears South 63°06'00" East a distance of 204.72 feet to the P.T. of said curve;

THENCE South 70°22'00" East along the Southwesterly right of way line of Pawhuska Drive a distance of 104.77 feet to the P.C. of a curve to the left;

THENCE continuing along the Southerly right of way line of Pawhuska Drive a distance of 256.78 feet along the arc of a curve to the left, whose central angle is 23°51'00", whose radius is 616.83 feet and whose long chord bears South 82°17'30" East a distance of 254.94 feet to the P.T. of said curve;

THENCE North 85°47'00" East along the Southerly right of way line of Pawhuska Drive a distance of 75.00 feet to the P.C. of a curve return to the right;

THENCE a distance of 31.41 feet along the arc of a curve to the right, whose central angle is 90°00'00", whose radius is 20.00 feet and whose long chord bears South 49°13'00" East a distance of 28.28 feet to a point lying in the Westerly right of way line of Sacramento Drive (50 foot wide road);

THENCE North 85°47'00" East across Sacramento Drive a distance of 50.00 feet to a point lying in the Easterly right of way line of Sacramento Drive;

THENCE South 04°13'00" East along the Easterly right of way line of Sacramento Drive a distance of 507.70 feet to a point lying in the Easterly right of way line of Sacramento Drive and said point being the true point of BEGINNING of the parcel of land being described and containing 62.108 acres of ground more or less.

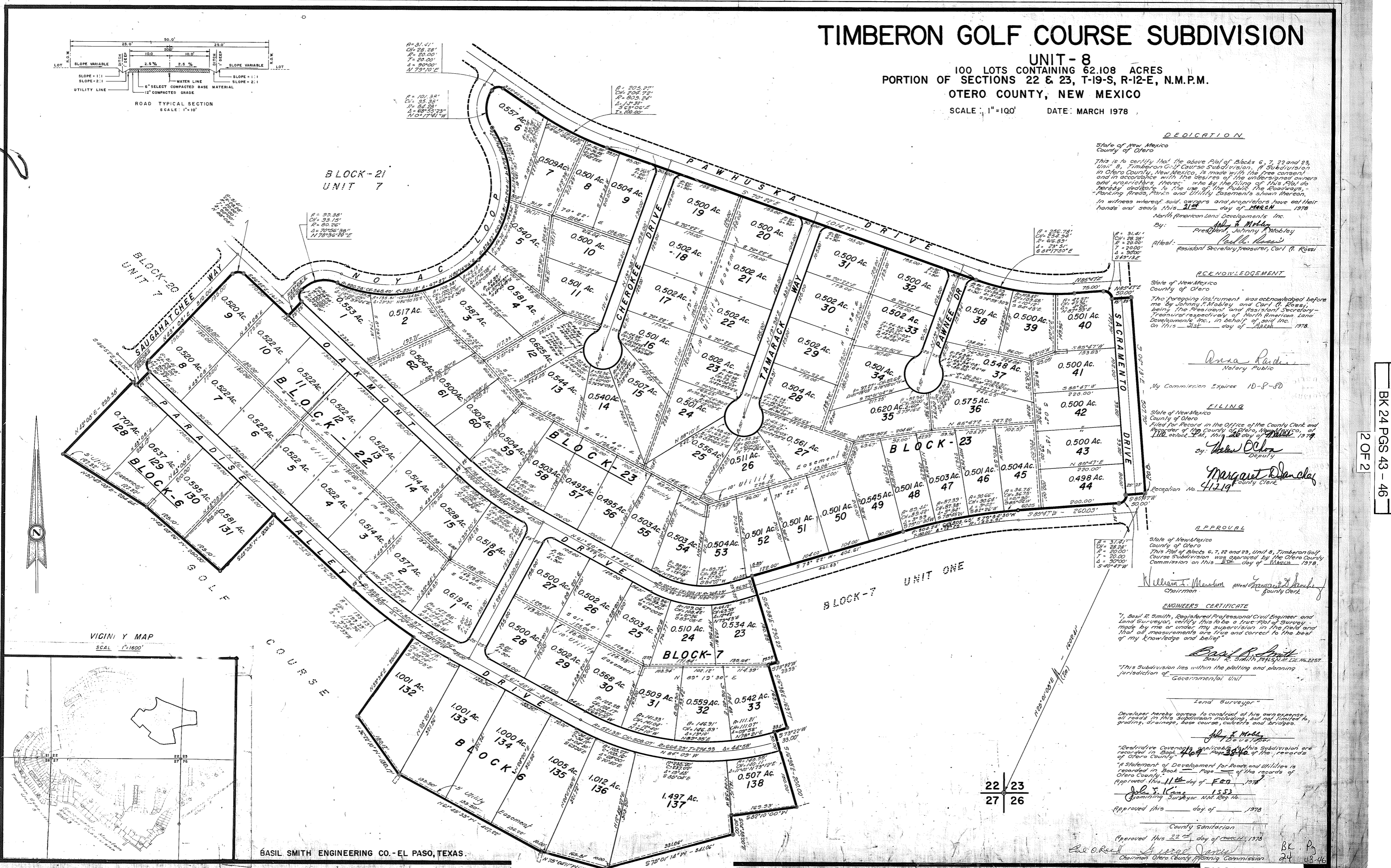
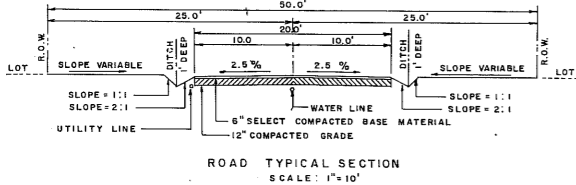

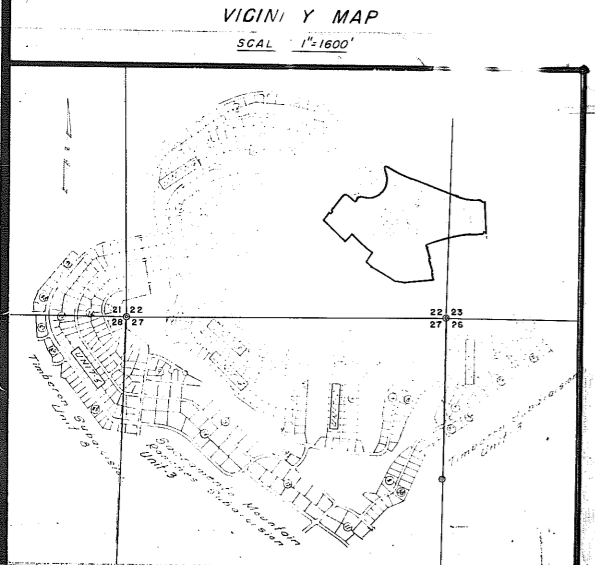
